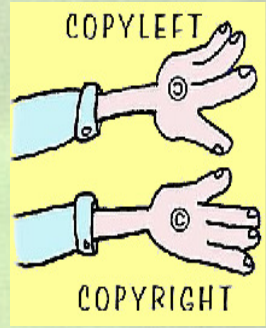
Problem
